**THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE
AREA D (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 1993
(AMENDMENT NO. 24) ORDER 2007**

Cambridgeshire County Council ("The Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 19, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 63, and 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") (as amended) and with the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation for all purposes on the 28th day of April 2008 and may be cited as The City of Cambridge Area D (Consolidation) Order 1993 (Amendment No. 24) Order 2007.

2. In this Order the expression "the Order of 1993" shall mean The City of Cambridge Area D (Consolidation) Order 1993 and any reference to the Order of 1993 shall be construed as a reference to that Order as varied or amended.

3. The Order of 1993 shall be amended and have effect as though Article 138 was deleted and substituted by the following:

138 Save as provided in Article 139 of this Order no person shall cause any motor vehicle the weight of which whether laden or unladen exceeds the maximum gross metric weight of 18 tonnes to proceed on any of the lengths of road specified in Part 2 of Schedule 18 to this Order

4. The Order of 1993 shall be amended and have effect as though Part 2 of Schedule 18 was deleted and substituted by the SCHEDULE to this Order.
