**THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE
AREA E (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 1993 (AMENDMENT NO. 33) ORDER 2000**

Cambridge City Council ("the Council") in pursuance of arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Cambridgeshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 19, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 63, and 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") (as amended) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation for all purposes on the 12th day of June 2000 and may be cited as The City of Cambridge Area E (Consolidation) Order 1993 (Amendment No.33) Order 2000.

2. In this Order the expression "the Order of 1993" shall mean The City of Cambridge Area E (Consolidation) Order 1993 and any reference to the Order of 1993 shall be construed as a reference to that Order as varied or amended.

3. The Order of 1993 shall be amended and have effect as though the following additions were made to Schedule 2 Part 2:

CHURCH END On its east side from the centreline of High Street for a distance of 32 metres in a northerly direction

CHURCH END On its west side from a point 48 metres north of the centreline of Coldham's Lane for a distance of 9 metres in a northerly direction

CHURCH END On its west side from a point 72 metres north of the centreline of Coldham's Lane for a distance of 31 metres in a northerly direction

CHURCH END On the northwest and northeast sides of the island at its junction with High Street

CHURCH END On both sides from a point 356 metres northwest of the centreline of March Lane northwestwards to its junction with Rosemary Lane

ROSEMARY LANE On its northeast side from a point 115 metres northeast of the centreline of Coldham's Lane northeastwards to its junction with Church End

ROSEMARY LANE On its southwest side from a point 104 metres northeast of the centreline of Coldham's Lane northeastwards to its junction with Church End

TEVERSHAM DRIFT On its north side from the centreline of the northeastern arm of its junction with Church End for a distance of 16 metres in a northeasterly direction
