**THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE
AREA E (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 1993 (AMENDMENT NO. 35) ORDER 2000**

Cambridge City Council ("the Council") in pursuance of arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Cambridgeshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 19, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 63, and 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") (as amended) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation for all purposes on the 12th day of March 2001 and may be cited as The City of Cambridge Area E (Consolidation) Order 1993 (Amendment No.35) Order 2000.

2. In this Order the expression "the Order of 1993" shall mean The City of Cambridge Area E (Consolidation) Order 1993 and any reference to the Order of 1993 shall be construed as a reference to that Order as varied or amended.

3. The Order of 1993 shall be amended and have effect as though the following addition was made to Article 2(1)

"disabled person's part footway part carriageway parking place" means an area of footway and carriageway of a specified highway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with Diagram 1028.3 in Schedule 6 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994 and is designated as a parking place for disabled person's vehicles by Article 106 of this Order;

4. The Order of 1991 shall be amended and have effect as though Articles 106,107, 108 and 112 to this Order were deleted and substituted by the following:

106. The parts of roads specified in all Part of Schedule 13 to this Order are designated as parking places for disabled people.

107 Each parking place specified in all Parts of Schedule 13 to this Order may be used subject to the provisions of this section of this Order for the waiting of any disabled person=s vehicle which displays a disabled persons badge.

108(1) Every vehicle left in a disabled persons parking place specified in Parts 1 and 3 of Schedule 13 to this Order shall so stand to be parallel to the kerb in the parking place and wholly within the limits of a parking bay delineated by white lines on the carriageway

108(2) Every vehicle left in a disabled persons parking place specified in Part 2 of Schedule 13 to this Order shall so stand to be parallel to the kerb in the parking place and wholly within the limits of a parking bay delineated by signs complying with Diagram 661 in Schedule 2 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994

108(3) Every vehicle left in a disabled persons parking place specified in Part 4 of Schedule 13 to this Order shall so stand to be parallel to the kerb in the parking place and wholly within the limits of a parking bay delineated by white lines on the footway and on the carriageway

112(1) Disabled persons parking places specified in Parts 1 and 4 of Schedule 13 to this Order shall remain in operation for all hours on all days.

112(2) Disabled persons parking places specified in Part 2 of Schedule 13 shall remain in operation on all days between 10am and 6am the following day

112(3) Disabled persons parking places specified in Part 3 of Schedule 13 shall remain in operation between 9am and 5pm Mondays to Saturdays

5. The Order of 1991 shall be amended and have effect by the addition of Schedule 13 Part 4 as specified by the SCHEDULE to this Order.
