

THE COUNTY OF CAMBRIDGESHIRE
(FITZROY STREET AND BURLEIGH STREET, CAMBRIDGE)
(PROHIBITION OF CYCLING)
ORDER 1996

The County of Cambridgeshire in exercise of the powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on 18th day of March 1996 and may be cited as "The County of Cambridgeshire (Fitzroy Street and Burleigh Street, Cambridge) (Prohibition of Cycling) Order 1996".
 2. (1) In this Order:-
 - "pedal cycle" means a cycle not being a mechanically propelled vehicle;
 - "restricted hours" means 10am to 4pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) Except where otherwise stated any reference in this order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
 - (4) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
 - (5) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by any other enactment.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any pedal cycle to proceed during the restricted hours in the roads or parts of road referred to in Schedule 1 to this Order.

4. Nothing in Article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any pedal cycle to proceed in the roads or parts of road referred to therein provided the person in charge of the pedal cycle shall have dismounted from the pedal cycle and shall walk with the pedal cycle.

5. Section 19 (Limited Access) of the City of Cambridge Area A (Consolidation) Order 1993 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though in Article 142 the following words were added:

"142(r) pedal cycle being ridden or wheeled by a pedestrian between the hours of 4.00pm and 10.00am Mondays to Saturdays and at any time on Sundays

142(s) pedal cycle being wheeled by a pedestrian between the hours of 10.00am and 4.00pm Mondays to Saturdays" .

6. Schedule 6 (One Way Streets) to the City of Cambridge Area A (Consolidation) Order 1993 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though the following words were deleted:

"ADAM AND EVE STREET From southwest to northeast (from its junction with Paradise Street to its junction with Burleigh Street)"

7. Part 2 of Schedule 16 (No Entry) to the City of Cambridge Area A (Consolidation) Order 1993 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though the following words were added:

"Adam and Eve Street At its junction with Burleigh Street from all directions".

8. Schedule 19 (Limited Access) to the City of Cambridge Area A (Consolidation) Order 1993 is hereby varied and shall have effect as though:

(i) for Burleigh Street (from its junction with Fitzroy Street to its junction with the line of the northwestern boundary of Adam and Eve Street) in Column 3 for the words "142 m,n" were substituted the words "142 n,r,s";

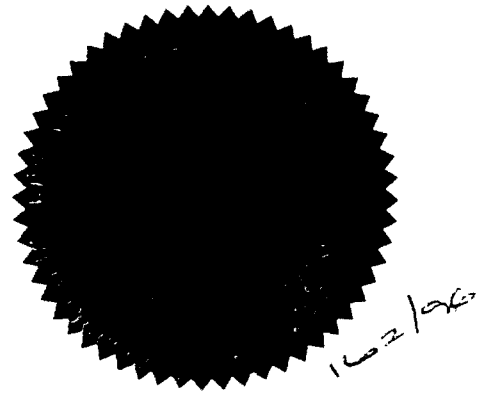
(ii) for Fitzroy Street (from its junction with Fair Street to the western boundary of No 36 Fitzroy Street) in Column 3 for the words "142 c,e,m" were substituted the words "142 c,e,r,s"; and

(iii) for Fitzroy Street (from the western boundary of

No 36 Fitzroy Street to its junction with Burleigh Street) in Column 3 for the words "142 m,n" were substituted the words "142 n,r,s".

9. The County of Cambridgeshire (Fitzroy Street and Burleigh Street, Cambridge) (Prohibition of Cycling) Experimental Traffic Order 1995 is hereby revoked.

PROHIBITION OF RIDING OF PEDAL CYCLES BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10AM TO 4PM MONDAYS TO SATURDAYS INCLUSIVE

Burleigh Street	from its junction with Fitzroy Street to its junction with the line of the northwestern boundary of Adam and Eve Street
Fitzroy Street	from its junction with Fair Street to its junction with Burleigh Street
