(AMENDMENT NO.14) ORDER 1998

Cambridge City Council ("the Council") in pursuance of arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Cambridgeshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 19, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 63, and 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") (as amended) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation for all purposes on the 6th day of July 1998 and may be cited as The City of Cambridge Area G (Consolidation) Order 1993 (Amendment No.14) Order 1998
- 2. In this Order the expression "the Order of 1993" shall mean The City of Cambridge Area G (Consolidation) Order 1993 and any reference to the Order of 1993 shall be construed as a reference to that Order as varied or amended.
- 3. The Order of 1993 shall be amended and have effect as though the following additions were made to Schedule 2 Part 2:

LUARD CLOSE (north-south arm)

LUARD CLOSE On the north side of the west-east arm from a (west-east arm) point 8 metres west of the centreline of the north-south arm eastwards for 16 metres.

4. The Order of 1993 shall be amended and have effect as though the following additions were made to Schedule 2 Part 29:

LUARD CLOSE On the north side of the west-east arm from a (west-east arm) point 8 metres west of the centreline of the north-south arm westwards to its most westerly point

LUARD CLOSE On the west side of the westernmost turning (westeast arm) head from its most northerly point for a distance of 3.5 metres in a southerly direction

LUARD CLOSE On the north side of the west-east arm from a point 8 metres east of the centreline of the north-south arm eastwards to its most easterly point

LUARD CLOSE On the east side of the easternmost turning (west-east arm) head from its most northerly point for a distance of 3.5 metres in a southerly direction
